CRC 2011 Hosted BY ASHRAE HKC

The fourteen Chapters Regional Conference (CRC) of Region XIII was held at Kowloon Shangri-La Hotel in Hong Kong on 19-20th August, 2011. There was one technical seminar with the theme of High Performance Building Design held in the morning session of CRC on 19th August, 2011. The seminar was well attended with 344 participants including local members , overseas members and the distinguished guests from the headquarters of ASHRAE. The technical seminar had included three technical presentations that was delivered by Mr. Ronald E. Jarnagin, ASHRAE President; Ir Chan Fan, Frank, the Deputy Director / Regulatory Services, EMSD of HKSAR; Mr. Kent W. Peterson, ASHRAE Distinguished Lecturer.

After the morning session of CRC on 19th August, 2011, there were business sessions be held for discussion the regional matters among seven Chapters, i.e., Hong Kong Chapter, Indonesia Chapter, Malaysia Chapter, Philippines Chapter, Singapore Chapter, Taiwan Chapter and Thailand Chapter in the afternoon of 19th and 20th August, 2011. It was well attended by 58 members including all Chapter delegates, Chapter alternates, local and overseas Chapter committee chairs as well as the distinguished guests from ASHRAE headquarters. There were two motions passed in the business sessions, such as:

- Motion One: To provide options to allow new and current Student members to pay membership fees for multiple years, such as 2, 3 or 4 years, at the time of the first entry.
- Motion Two: To adopt the Region 13 Refrigeration Award of Excellence Point in the category of Presidential Award of Excellence.

The above two motions should be moved for discussion at the Society level in the coming Winter Meeting in Chicago.

Date of event: 22rd to 28th Aug, 2011

ASHRAE Study Tour is one of the famous yearly activities organized for students. The study tour has been held for many years and reached many places, such as Taiwan, Thailand, and Singapore. Total 15 students from City University of Hong Kong (CityU), Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU), Hong Kong University (HKU) and University of Science and Technology (HKUST) took part in this korean tour from 22rd August to 28th August in 2011 summer.

During the seven-day trip, students visited four universities and two institutes named Seoul National University, Ewha Womans University, Yonsei University, Chungnam National University, Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (KAIST) and Korea Institute of Energy Research (KIER). These visits not only acquiring engineering knowledge of students, but also can they had precious opportunities to have academic and cultural exchange with the local students through these universities' exchange.

Technical Workshop High Performance Building Design

Date of event: 1st and 2rd Jul, 2011



After the fruitful CRC technical seminar on 20th August 2011, the next morning, our Society Past pPresident as well as Distinguished Lecturer Mr. Kent Peterson, was again invited by ASHRAE Hong Kong Chapter and Hong Kong Green Building Council (HKGBC) to joinly organize a technical workshop about High Performance Building Design.

In the workshop, Mr. Kent Peterson talked about the essentials of high performance green building design, attributes including occupant productivity, energy efficiency, water efficiency, durability and life-cycle performance.

The ASHRAE Advanced Energy Design Guides (AEDG), a series of publications designed to provide recommendations for achieving energy savings over the minimum code requirements of ANSI/ASHRAE/IESNA Standard 90.1 which is the first step in the process toward achieving a net zero energy building which is defined as a building that, on an annual basis, draws from outside resources equal or less energy than it provides using on-site, renewable energy sources. The original series of guides have an energy savings target of 30% over 90.1-1999. A series of guides with an energy savings of 50% over 90.1-2004 are now underway. Mr. Kent Peterson showed the attendee how they achieve 50% energy reduction from the guides.

Lastly HKGBC, BEAM Faculty member Ir Dr Raymond Yau and ASHRAE HK Chapter Past President Mr. Tim Cheng presented Certificate of Appreication to thank Mr. Kent Peterson for his contribution. There were total of 55 participants including BEAM Pro, HKGBC members and ASHRAE members.

Leadership Interview with Dr. Philip Yu

1. How did you decide to join engineering as your career?

Engineer was my dream and eventually felt in love at my first job at Harbour City, where I was studying the chilled water system and making proposals to improve energy performance, etc.

However, one can hardly be recognized as an Engineer unless he/she becomes a full member of HKIE. So I studied hard at work for this recognition in early years of my engineering career. In this process, I knew more engineering friends and found that we can indeed contribute even more as an engineer.

2. What's the key to success?

Depending how you define "success", I would say that it's very important to set our personal vision with achievable goals. Then work hard to reach the goals and the success will be realized along with goals being achieved one after another.

For me, I try to set a goal for the next stage as soon as it is reached and never give up at difficult time.

My perseverance in PhD studies – painful but rewarding, especially for a full-time worker – was inspired by Mr. S K Wang, HVAC&R lecturer at PloyU. I guess many seniors in the industry know him or have been his students like myself. I was involved in his effort of publishing the Handbook of Air Conditioning and Refrigeration and its 2nd edition. Even dying, he was still working hard on its 3rd edition! Obviously he has set the standard for success in my heart and probably in many young engineers' hearts.

3. What's your career outlook?

I think the world is facing more and more environmental challenges and our next generations are running out of natural resources. It is everyone's responsibility to save the Earth or preserve the natural resources for our next generations. Engineers can play a key role, esp. those involved in building design, construction, installation, commissioning, operation and maintenance. To be a "responsible" engineer you will be successful in your career.

4. What made you join ASHRAE? How do you feel about this big family?

Everyone knows that ASHRAE has so many standards and handbooks... what's even amazing is that they are all created by volunteers. As I mentioned earlier, as engineers, we may contribute even more. So I joined ASHRAE!

You are right to say ASHRAE is a big family. In 1992, I returned from the U.S. and my ex-lecturer Prof. Daniel Chan brought me to HK Chapter where I got to know one of the great founders, Dr. Edwin Tao and many "big brothers" of the industry. They were very kind and friendly, treated and taught me like younger brother. Not only that we had just a few members serving the Chapter at that time but also enjoyed a laissez-faire organization, or "do what you want". In other words, we were pretty free to try new things such as launching the Chapter's Student Quality Projects campaign (1995) and official website (1996). Past-presidents and other chapter leaders were very supportive. In fact, I learned a lot from them including leadership style, effective business meeting (e.g. Robert's Rule of Order), team work, etc.

Dr. Roger Chu, one of my favorite ex-lecturers, highly encouraged the young generation to participate and we were empowered to take responsibilities... I did most of work in organizing the 5th annual joint symposium, ASHRAE's Centennial cum HK Chapter's 10th anniversary, Region XIII 2nd CRC, etc. All these background led me to the youngest Chapter President (1996-97) and the first RVC for Chapter Program (1998-2001) as well as the exposure to many Society Committee meetings where I really found ASHRAE a big family!

5. What achievement you feel the most honourable in ASHRAE? What's the largest challenge you had faced? And what's most impressed you?

Most honourable: published COOL Hong Kong – the Chapter's first book and the collective effort of 25 members.

Most impressive: on 25-26 Jan. 1997 at the ASHRAE winter meetings in Philadelphia, working with members of different countries from Far East (HK, Singapore and Malaysia) and some passionate U.S. members till 2 am to brainstorm ideas and to prepare a motion to form a Far East region (today known as Region XIII, the first ASHRAE region outside North America) that would represent our member's voice as well as link the members more directly to the Society!

Most challenging: Presidency, esp. being the youngest president in the Chapter's history; but Dr. Chu, Edwin Tao, Vincent Tse, and many others had given a lot of support and guidance.
